



Disable Driver Signing Windows 8

Here is the checklist to disable the driver signing for Windows 8

1. Windows Key + R.
2. Enter "shutdown.exe /r /o /f /t 0" – (last character is a zero) this tells the computer to restart and prompt how you want to start.
3. Click the "OK".
4. The system will restart to a menu allowing you to change how it boots.
5. Select "Troubleshoot".
6. Select "Advanced options".
7. Select "Windows Start up Settings" – this will restart Windows and let us change the boot options 8. Click "Restart" button.
8. System will restart to "Advanced Boot Options" screen.
9. Select "Disable Driver Signature Enforcement" – this tells the computer to boot without forcing signed drivers.
10. Reboot the computer and install the device driver as normal (either using the installer if available or Device Manager).

At that point, you have ONE BOOT SESSION in which the driver can still be installed via the "usual" method.
