

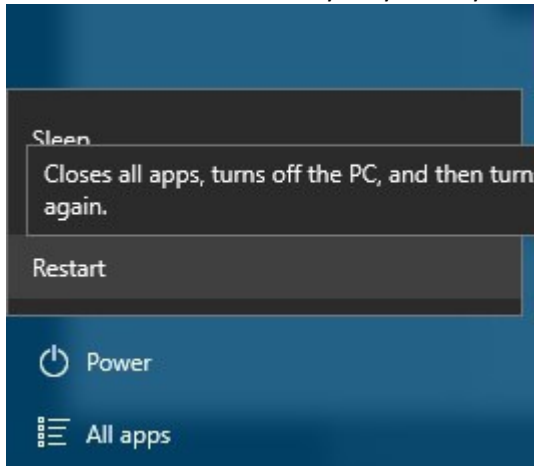


# Disable Driver Signing Windows 10

Here is the checklist to disable the driver signing for Windows 10

This is the simplest way to disable driver signature enforcement on Windows 10, but bear in mind that this method will only disable driver signature temporarily. After you restart your computer driver signature enforcement will automatically turn itself on. To disable driver signature enforcement do the following:

1. Press and hold the **Shift** key on your keyboard and click the **Restart** button.



2. Choose **Troubleshoot > Advanced options > Startup Settings** and click the **Restart** button.
3. When your computer restarts you'll see a list of options. Press **F7** on your keyboard to select **Disable driver signature enforcement**.
4. Your computer will now restart and you'll be able to install unsigned drivers as normal (either using the installer if available or Device Manager).

At that point, you have ONE BOOT SESSION in which the driver can still be installed via the "usual" method.
